

Dear Resident,

I write to apologise unreservedly to you for the appalling disturbance which emanated from the Stag Brewery on the evening of Wednesday 16th May.

Firstly the exercise undertaken was not sanctioned to take place after 6pm.

Secondly the use of helicopters landing on the Stag Brewery site is something that our client would never have sanctioned at any time and certainly not being used so late at night.


The use of the site by the anti-terrorist police divisions, police dog handlers, Special Forces and close protection police officers for their training is something our client has permitted, free of charge and to assist them in their vital training. Normally start and finish times are agreed and if there is noise involved we insist on leafletting to neighbours so that they are forewarned and consultation with the local police to ensure safety for those living or moving about in close proximity to the site.

On this occasion there has been a serious breach of trust and we have asked those responsible to apologise to you directly.

I want to assure you that such a breach will not happen again.

Representations are being made concerning this outrageous disturbance at the highest level within the MOD and I hope a proper apology to you will be forthcoming from the perpetrators in the very near future.
